

# 2007 "Buren" Cabernet Sauvignon

## Details

<b>Grape Variety/Origination</b>	100% Cabernet Sauvignon, Buren Vineyard Applegate Valley
<b>Growing Conditions:</b>	A mild year with a cooler, wetter harvest. Careful planning and quick reflexes were needed to harvest in the windows. Buren vineyard did very well in this vintage, with excellent flavors and chemistry.
<b>Winemaker Comments:</b>	We like the Buren vineyard because it consistently delivers fruit with great aromatics and richness. The vines are planted on well drained, gravelly soils near the Applegate River. The Buren Vineyard has become our premiere Cabernet site.
<b>Tasting Comments:</b>	With a similar profile to previous vintages, this year's Buren evokes classic baked plum, currant, and baking spice aromas overlaying a small amount of vanilla and cinnamon. Tannins are round and balanced, the mouthfeel is nice and plush with a great finish. At this time, it benefits from decanting or a bit of time in the glass. Should age well.
